Goals for this year:

- Safe and Caring School

New initiatives:

- Practical Arts programming – robotics, bike shop due to assistance from a grant through Pembina Trails
- Breakfast program – as of January we started a breakfast program with the assistance of St. Paul's Anglican Church Community, Fort Garry United, Fort Garry Legion, along with school staff and many
- Distributed student leadership/student voice – each class had an opportunity to be a leader at school!
- Peer tutoring program – trained with Vincent Massey tutors
- Regular Math cross grade enrichment groups including participating in Gauss and Perennial Math contests
- Free the Children club – active throughout the year in providing fundraising and volunteering opportunities for students
- Mental Health training and focus – all Grade 7 teachers and 2 Grade 8 teachers, Support Services and Administration trained in Mental Health First Aid
- Cultural Awareness – artists, workshops, Family Metis evening
- Incorporating character trait themes at each of our monthly assemblies
- Continued work with Marie Geelen and area of respect
- Continued work in the area of appropriate use of technology – lessons in Health, Habiletés de vie, classroom discussions
- Flex timetabling in the Grade 8 classes with Student Services available

Literacy Outcomes:

91% of our students are meeting or beyond grade level expectations in French. 88% of our students are meeting or beyond grade level expectations in English. In both areas of reading, this is an increase of 3% in each reading area from last year.
